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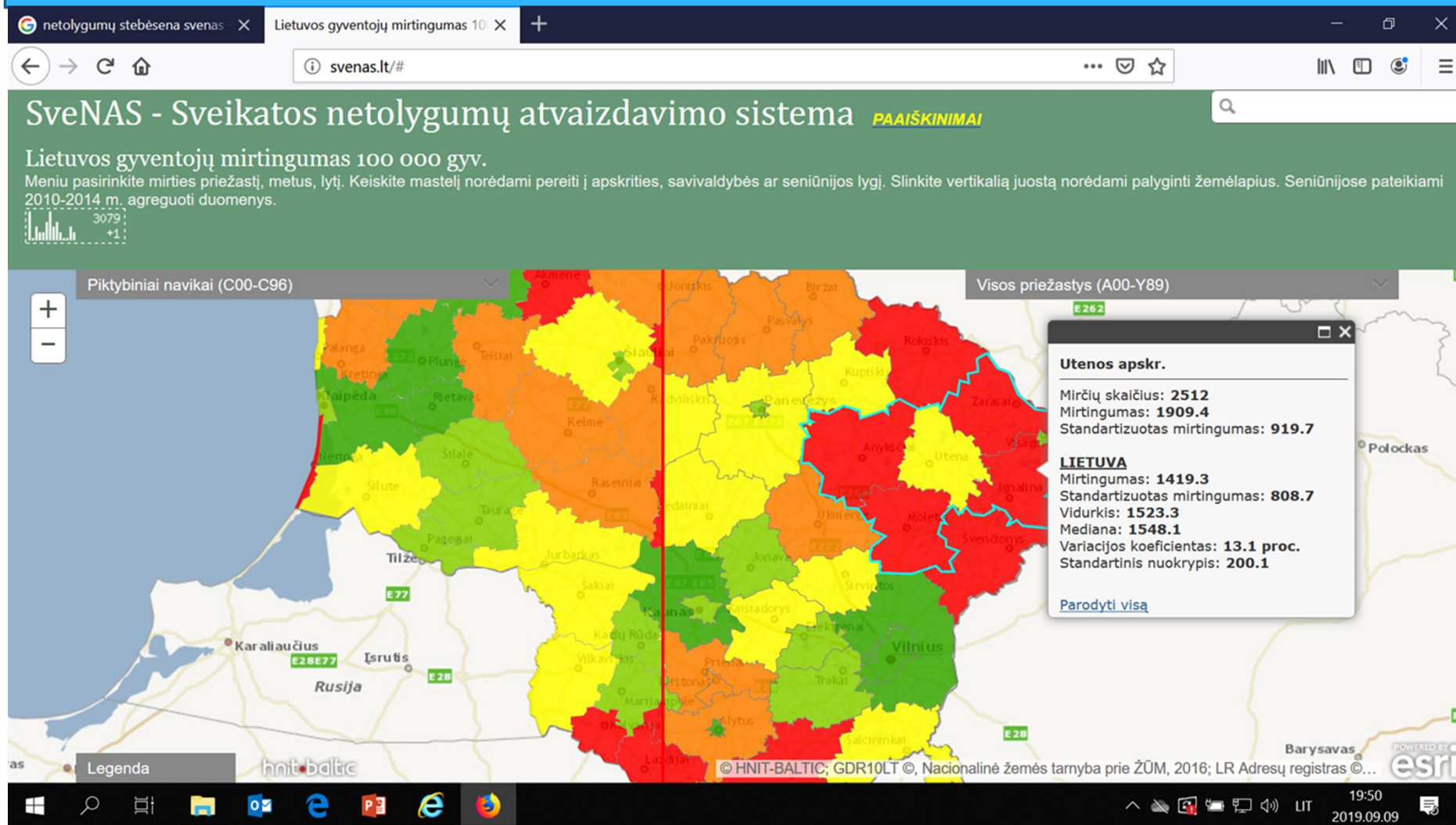

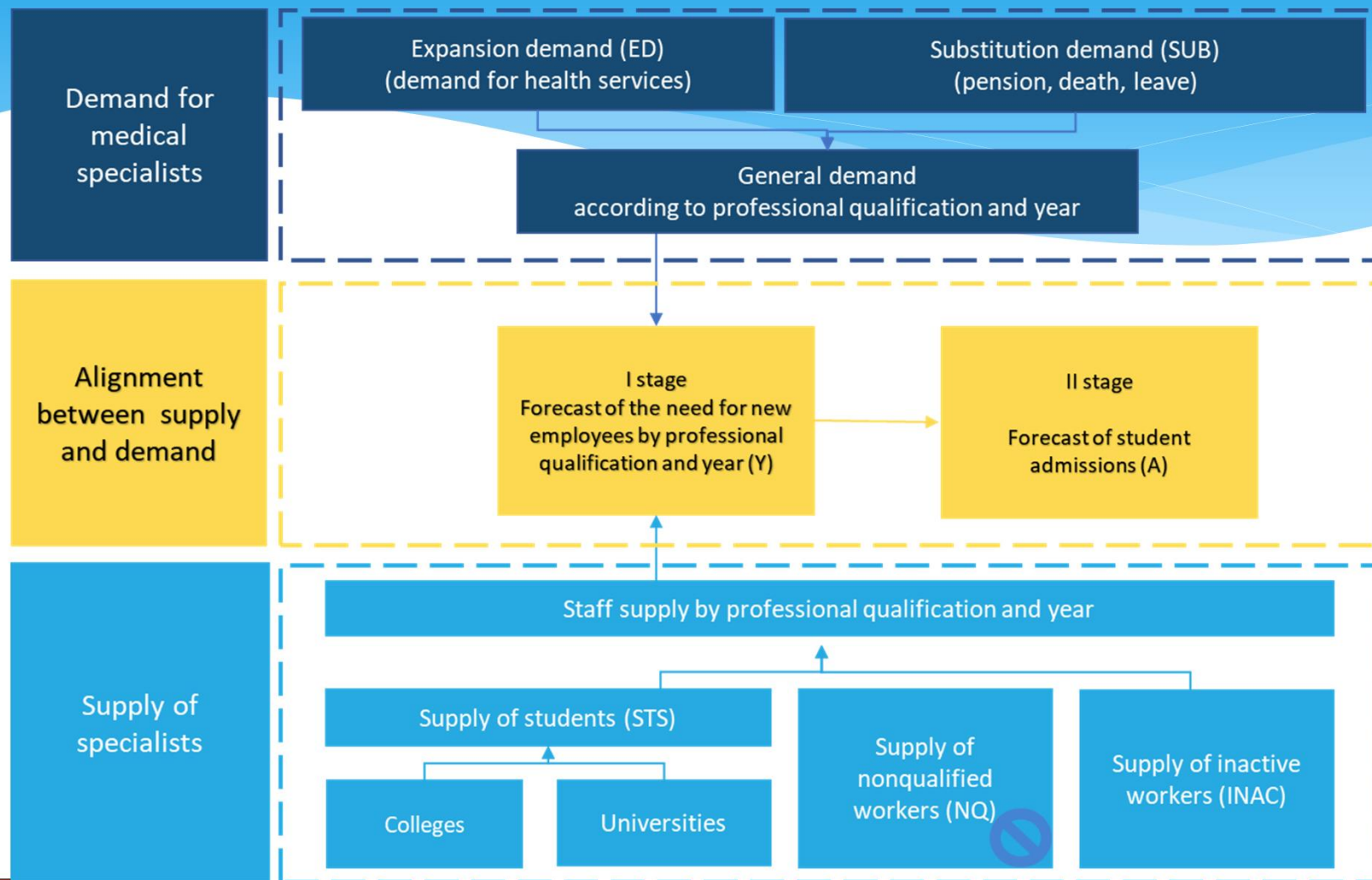

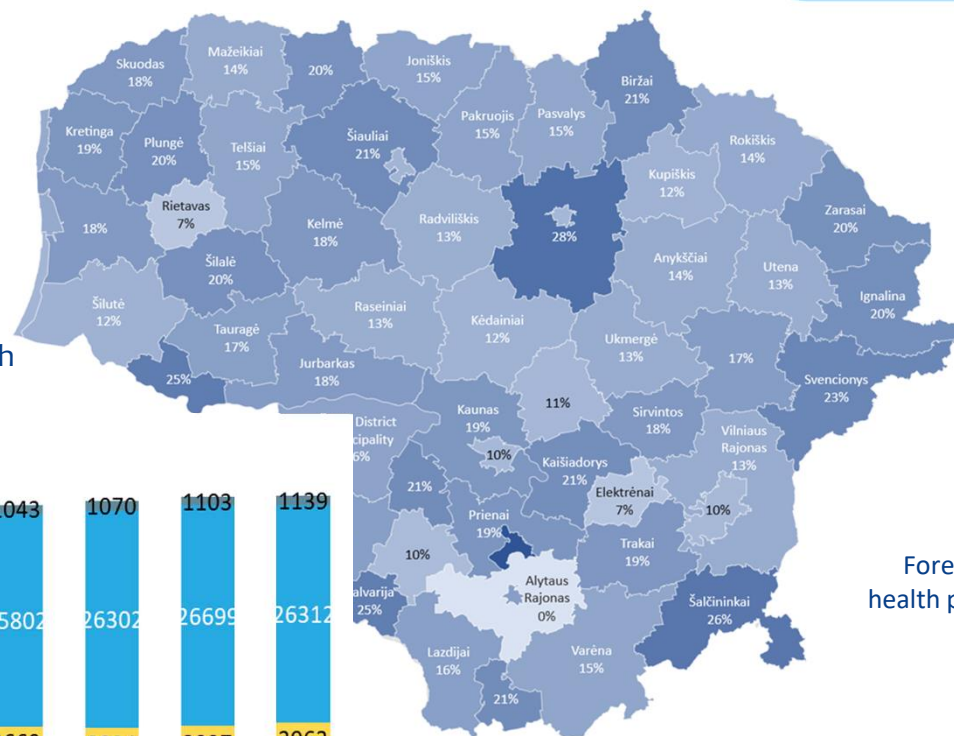
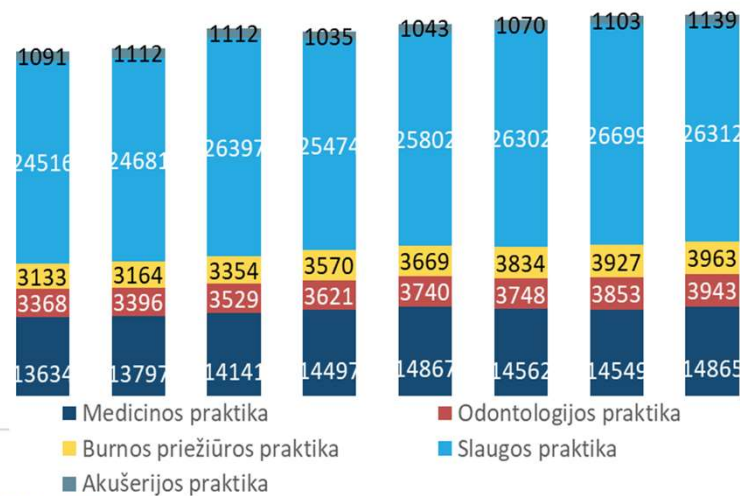

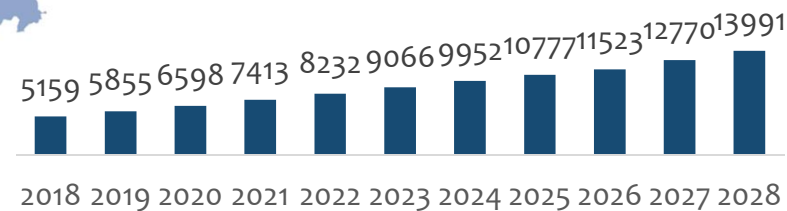

## Distribution of retirement age health professionals by municipality (2018)

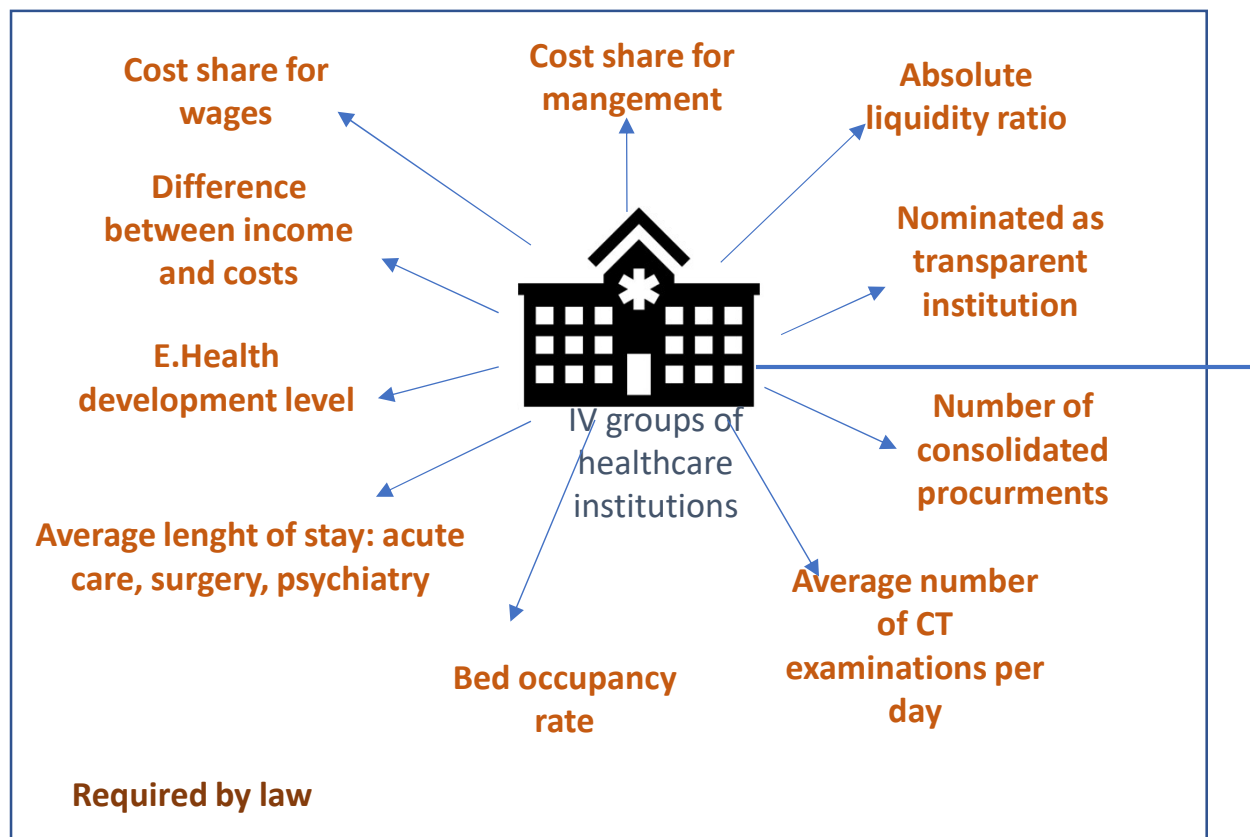
Number of licensed health specialists by 1 January of each year

# Benchmarking healthcare institutions performance



## State Patient Fund and 5 Territorial patient branches monitor:

- Individual health care services provided on the primary, secondary and tertiary levels of health activities;
- Preventive medical assistance (provision of information on the issues of disease prophylaxis, prophylactic health check-ups of the insured, as prescribed by the Ministry of Health, cervical, breast, colorectal, prostate cancer screening programmes, etc.);
- Medical rehabilitation services;
- Nursing care and social services, supportive treatment services at nursing and supportive treatment hospitals;
- Consumption of reimbursable medicines;
- Performance indicators of health care institutions;
- Etc.
